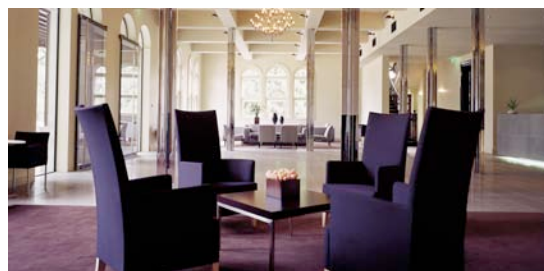

TRANSPORT TO AND FROM MELBOURNE AIRPORT

A free bus will be provided to transport delegates from Tullamarine (Melbourne) Airport to Werribee and back again. Pick up time on Thursday 17 June will be 9.30am outside the Qantas arrivals section. Arriving Werribee at 10.15am.
