



Over \$1,000 Worth of Dental Treatment for Your Kids

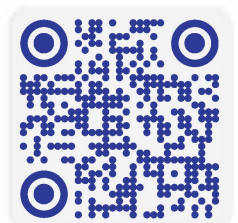
By having regular dental visits from a young age, kids can set up good oral health habits for a lifetime – now that’s something to smile about!

Children may be able to access a range of basic dental services* at no cost, using the Medicare Child Dental Benefits Schedule (CDBS).

The Child Dental Benefits Schedule covers over \$1,000 worth of dental treatment every 2 years, for eligible children** 17 years and under.

*Basic dental services may include: Check-ups, teeth cleaning, fillings, fissure sealants, x-rays, extractions, and root canal. Excludes orthodontics, treatment under general anaesthetic, cosmetic dental treatment, and mouthguards.
 **Eligible children include: Recipients of certain Medicare benefits (Family Tax Benefit A) and Centrelink payments. Treatment is covered to the value of over \$1,000 every 2 years. Fees may apply after entitlements are reached.
