What you need to know and acknowledge before you register:

- If you're a 1st or 2nd year ADA graduate member, you must provide formal evidence of your date of qualification or first registration. To be eligible for the Dental 1st Year Graduate registration rate, the date of qualification must be within 18 months prior to the Congress date.
